

## **UPPER SCHOOL**

The Upper School, based around Cloister House, aims to bridge the World of School and the World of Work. Students are admitted from the School and from other places who can benefit from our programme that is designed to help them towards independence. We cater for young people between 17 and 21+.

In the morning, after helping with those chores that help the smooth running of the House, they study a range of subjects under the heading of Continuing Education. They take part in musical and artistic activities alongside individual literacy and numeracy as well as Life Skills. In the afternoons they engage in Craft based activities such as Pottery, Woodwork, Leatherwork as well as Land based work in the Medicinal Plant Garden, Vegetable Garden and the Farm. During the evenings and weekends there is a programme of cultural and recreational activities including outings to places of interest.
